

Dear parents,

The Ministry of Education, Children and Youth has been committed since the start of the 2024-2025 school year to raising awareness among children and parents of the need for a screen-life balance, i.e. a balance between screens and real-life experiences. This campaign focuses on both formal and non-formal education.

According to the Ministry's regulations, a complete prohibition on smartphones (including connected watches) will be introduced, after the Easter holidays, in education and childcare facilities for schoolchildren in the same way as in primary education.

In future, smartphones and connected watches must be switched off and kept in the schoolbag at all times when children are at school and in the Maison Relais (including at recreation time, on school transport and during trips and excursions).

If these rules are not observed, the device will be confiscated by SEAS staff and may be collected from SEAS by the parents.

Students and their parents are always responsible for their personal equipment. Under no circumstances will SEAS be held responsible for loss, theft or potential damage.

However, the use of digital tools remains authorized in the context of pedagogical activities, which are part of non-formal education, as well as for the documentation of pedagogical offers or the administrative work of SEAS staff.
